ADRA Lebanon works with people in poverty and distress to create just and positive change through empowering partnerships and responsible action.

Our Impact

In all ADRA projects, our experts work together to maximise the impact of our activities.

- **FOOD SECURITY** – 3,819 people have benefited from monthly food assistance.
- **WASH** – 30,000 families now have access to clean water and improved hygiene environments.
- **ENVIRONMENT** - 749 families were provided with households and garbage bins for improved waste management.
- **EMERGENCY RESPONSE** – 1,445 households have been helped through ADRA's emergency cash assistance.
- **EDUCATION** – 1,565 boys and girls have benefited from ADRA's non-formal education program.
- **LIVELIHOODS** – 26 youth have received life skills training. 32 small to medium enterprises received cash grants in response to the Beirut blast damages.
